What Is CanSkate?

CanSkate is the nationally recognized learn-to-skate program offered by the club, developed by Skate Canada for beginner skaters of all ages. The program teaches the basics to skating in a progressive fun setting using continuous movement. Once the skater reaches the advanced level of CanSkate nearer the end of the seven stages they move into our Junior Academy Program.

What is Jr. Academy

These are skaters who are approaching more of a Figure Skating Skills oriented path. The skaters learn more of the edges, speed, flow and form which enables them to jump and spin, do dances and various set pattern Skating Skills.
