Administration and Volunteer Fees

Club Administration Fee:

All STAR and Competitive skaters are required to remit Club Administration fee of \$113 (this includes Skate Canada Membership fee).

Club Administrative fee for NON-RESIDENT members is \$113, no Volunteer fee required

Discount: 10% Discount for all Skate Winnipeg Members

Family Discount: For a family of 2 skaters or more, IF each skater registers for more than 4 hours each, the ice fee for the 2nd and subsequent skaters within the family will be discounted at 10%. The discount will be calculated after registration is completed and will be refunded within 30 days of registration.

Volunteer Fees:

Skate Winnipeg is a not-for-profit, volunteer run organization. Family participation is required for the effective and successful operation of Skate Winnipeg. Every family that has a skater at Skate Winnipeg is required to volunteer.

The volunteer commitment is **10 hrs per skater Star 6-Gold/Competitive, 6 hrs per skater Star 1-5 or 14 hrs for families** with more than one skater.

Included in the commitment is ALL Skate Winnipeg Skaters are required to volunteer a minimum of **2 hours at Super Skate Competition**.

This per family commitment must be completed within the skating season, which runs from September 1st to August 31st. A volunteer fee will be invoiced to your account if all requirements are not met within the season.

Club Policies and Procedures

Refund Policy:

Skate Winnipeg reserves the right to cancel any program for which there is insufficient paid registration.

Sessions are non-transferable and there are no refunds for missed sessions.

NO refunds after the earlier of the dates indicated in the registration system or the start date of each session. All approved refunds will be subjected to a \$25 Administration charge.

If injured, refunds will ONLY be considered when accompanied by a medical note fully explaining the injury and the required time off.

Refunds will be considered where public health guidelines affect program delivery or facility operation, or where self-isolation is required. An administrative fee will be charged for all refunds issued, except those related to the COVID-19 pandemic situation.

Skate Winnipeg Parent and Skater Code of Conduct

All Skate Winnipeg skaters and parents participating in Skate Winnipeg Sessions must have a current signed Code of Conduct on file. Non-Skate Winnipeg skaters participating in Skate Winnipeg sessions are also expected to abide by the Code of Conduct and should familiarize themselves with it. **All completed Codes of Conduct must be submitted by October 1, 2020..**

COVID 19 Protocols

Waiver - Everyone who enters a facility where Skate Winnipeg programs are scheduled is required to submit a waiver prior to participating in any activities.
