***Maximum number of skaters per 1/2 ice surface is 10 excluding coaches as of March 23). The program will run with 2 groups of skaters using 1/2 ice surface. The groups will not intersect on the session in accordance with Public Health Requirements.**

***All Participants must wear masks in the facility and while participating on the ice.**

What is CANSKATE?

CANSKATE is a dynamic learn-to-skate program that focuses on fun, participation and basic skill development. CANSKATE centers on physical literacy and the fundamental skills needed to take part in **any ice sport** or to skate as a recreational activity.

COVID 19 PROTOCOLS
