## Club Policies and Procedures

### Policy on Prioritizing Registrations

1. All Sessions will be open to Skate Winnipeg Skaters registration March 23-March 30
2. After March 30 registration opens for non Skate Winnipeg Members
3. Closing date of registration is April 2 or until sessions are full.
4. Sessions are sold in blocks. Partial sessions will only be considered once ALL full session skaters are accommodated.
5. Skaters must meet the session qualifications for the session registered.
6. Registration will be completed online, all payments will be made in designated installments
7. Sessions are **NOT transferable**
8. Casual Bookings will be considered no later than 24 hours in advance of a session. Casual Ice fees will vary depending on the length of session requested. Skaters must contact [headcoach@skatewinnipeg.ca](mailto:headcoach@skatewinnipeg.ca) to confirm session availability and confirm fees for the session.

### Refund Policy

Skate Winnipeg reserves the right to cancel any program for which there is insufficient paid registration.

Sessions are non-transferable and there are no refunds for missed sessions.

NO refunds after the earlier of the dates indicated in the registration system or the start date of each session. All approved refunds will be subjected to a \$25 Administration charge.

If injured, refunds will ONLY be considered when accompanied by a medical note fully explaining the injury and the required time off.

Refunds will be considered where public health guidelines affect program delivery or facility operation, or where self-isolation is required. An administrative fee will be charged for all refunds issued, except those related to the COVID-19 pandemic situation.

## COVID 19 Protocols

**Waiver** - Everyone who enters a facility where Skate Winnipeg programs are scheduled is required to submit a waiver prior to participating in any activities.

This includes skaters, coaches, volunteers, board members, Program Assistants, spectators, parents, officials, etc. If you are there for Skate Canada programs or figure skating related activities, you must complete a waiver.
