Session Information

Sessions include ice time only. Lesson time is not included in fees. Lessons must be booked prior to registration with a coach. New Members must purchase a Skate Canada Membership/Insurance-Fee \$58.65. All new participants will be required to remit a \$25 Administrative Fee.

Refund Policy

NO refunds after the earlier of the dates indicated in the registration system or the start date of each session. All approved refunds will be subject to a \$30 administration charge. If injured, refunds will be considered when accompanied by confirmation from a medical professional that an injury has occurred and that a recommended period of recovery or participation restriction is required, including the anticipated duration of time away from skating. Skate Winnipeg does not request or retain detailed medical information. Refunds or credits will only be considered for sessions missed due to injury when the recommended time away from skating exceeds two (2) consecutive weeks. No refunds or credits will be issued for injuries requiring less than two weeks away from participation.
