Skate Winnipeg Group Programs 2026-2027 cont.

Group Programs Registration fees include coaching and ice time. All Group Programs Include 100% Coach Directed Class Time. Additional Ice Time/Session Registration fees include ice time only. Lesson time is not included in additional ice time/session registration fees. Skaters participating on additional ice time/sessions must arrange coaching prior to completing registration.

All Skaters: Group, STAR, Podium Pathway, Adult session skaters are required to a remit club administration fee of \$128.75 (this includes Skate Canada membership fee of \$60.70).

Volunteer Fees

Skate Winnipeg is a not-for-profit, volunteer run organization. Family participation is required for the effective and successful operation of Skate Winnipeg. Every family that has a skater at Skate Winnipeg is required to volunteer. This per family commitment must be completed within the skating season, which runs from September 1st to August 31st.

A volunteer fee will be charged (\$250) to your account if paying registration fees in full, and reimbursed if season volunteer requirements are complete on August 31, 2027.

When paying registration fees in installments the volunteer fee(\$250) will be charged only if all requirements are not met within the season on August 31, 2027.

Skate Winnipeg reserves the right to cancel any program for which there is insufficient paid registration. Sessions are non-transferable and there are no refunds for missed sessions. NO refunds after the earlier of the dates indicated in the registration system or the start date of each session. All approved refunds will be subject to a \$30 administration charge. If injured, refunds will ONLY be considered when accompanied by a medical note fully explaining the injury and the required time off.
